





The "Southwestern Asian and North African (SWANA) Response to Freedom of Religion or Belief (FoRB)" Consultation was held on December 2 and 3, 2022, at the Elias Beach Hotel in Limassol, Cyprus, with a total of 20 participants - secular, atheist, agnostic, and faith-based (Muslim and Christian) scholars and experts from multi and interdisciplinary fields, representatives from civil

THE CONSULTATION

1) FoRB, Political Agendas and the Context of Southwestern Asia and North Africa; 2) Religious and Non-Religious Individual and Community Rights, and Diversity Management in Southwestern Asia and North Africa; 3) FoRB, Personal Status Laws and Gender Equality in Southwestern Asia and North Africa). The consultation's main goal was to produce a regional response to FoRB and provide a platform for SWANA stakeholders to share practices and experiences about freedom of religion or belief in SWANA. The participants discussed the challenges in addressing issues related to freedom of religion or belief in SWANA, its implications, opportunities, and strategies, as well as identified contextualized recommendations and possible steps to move forward.
